MINUTES OF A MEETING OF THE STATE WATER CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Held in the Great Northern Hotel, Devils Lake, North Dakota, at 5:30 o'clock p.m. November 18, 1949

A special meeting of the State Water Conservation Commission was held in the Great Northern Hotel at Devils Lake, North Dakota, on November 18, 1949.

MEMBERS OF THE STATE WATER CONSERVATION COMMISSION PRESENT:

Hon. Fred G. Aandahl, Governor and Ex Officio Chairman S. W. Thompson, Vice Chairman, Devils Lake, North Dakota Einar H. Dahl, Commissioner from Watford City, ""Curtis Olson, Commissioner from Valley City, ""A. M. Christensen, Commissioner from Minot, ""J. J. Walsh, Secretary and Chief Engineer, Bismarck, North Dakota

Einar Berge, Publicity Director, Bismarck, North Dakota

The meeting was called to order by Governor Fred G. Aandahl as Chairman, at 5:30 o'clock p.m., with Commissioners Thompson, Einar Dahl, Olson, Christensen and Secretary Walsh present.

Governor Aandahl's letter to Major General Pick with reference to Resolutions submitted by the Devils Lake Chamber of Commerce and the Devils Lake City Commission, requesting the Commission to take action in having Garrison Reservoir named "Lake Thompson" was discussed by the Commission. It was felt that no action should be taken on this matter until after General Pick has replied to Governor Aandahl's letter.

A letter from Mr. S. E. Turnbow and Son, making application for an extension of their lease for another two-year period was discussed. Commissioner Olson made a motion that the lease be extended for another two-year period at the present rate of \$266 per year, providing that all rental payments for the past two years have been paid, before signing any new lease, as shown in the former lease agreement. This motion was seconded by Commissioner Einar Dahl. Upon call of the roll by Governor Aandahl, Commissioners Olson, Thompson, Einar Dahl, Christensen and Governor Aandahl all voted aye. Motion carried.

A letter from the Bank of North Dakota, dated November 10, with reference to the Series "J" Bonds of the State Water Conservation Commission, informed the Commission that a total of \$1,260 was due and payable on December 10.

Commissioner A. M. Christensen moved that payment of \$1,260 be approved and that the Chairman and Secretary of the Commission be authorized to negotiate with the Bank of North Dakota for payment of the above amount. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Einar Dahl. Governor Aandahl called roll, with Commissioners Einar Dahl, Thompson, Olson, Christensen and Governor Aandahl all voting aye. Motion carried.

Commissioner Olson reported that negotiations were under way to secure the necessary "assurances" in connection with alterations of roads, highways and bridges in the Baldhill Reservoir area, and that this matter had been attended to.

The members of the Commission recessed for dinger at 6:00 o'clock P.M.

Bruce Johnson, Acting District Manager of the Bureau of Reclamation, met with the Commission and reported on the construction work of the Heart-Butte dam, stating that the structure will be completed this year. However, during construction it was necessary to cut off the flow of the river, and now they are planning on installing pumps to bring the river flow back to its normal stage at this period of the year. After further discussion, it was the opinion of the Commission that an Order be directed to Mr. Johnson requesting that immediate action be taken to provide means for restoring the flow below the dam, in order to provide water for domestic and stock purposes.

Commissioner Einar Dahl made a motion that the chairman and Secretary direct an Order to Mr. Johnson, Acting District Manager of the Bureau of Reclamation, Bismarck, ordering the Bureau of Reclamation to release the normal flow of the Heart River for domestic and stock uses. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Christensen. Upon a unanimous vote of the Commission, the motion carried.

The meeting adjourned at 9:30 o'clock P.M.
